2. **Language Proficiency:** IELTS (usually 6.0-7.0+) or TOEFL scores.
3. **Motivation Letter (Statement of Purpose):** Explaining goals.
4. **Curriculum Vitae (CV/Resume):** Detailing background.
5. **Recommendation Letters (LORs):** From professors/employers.
6. **Passport Copy:** Valid passport.
7. **Application Fee:** Pay university specific fees.
8. **Portfolio (For Creative Courses):** If required.
9. **GMAT/GRE (For Specific Programs):** Often MBA/Master's in Finance.
10. **Proof of Funds:** For visa/residency (after acceptance).
